- Member of at least one LDE team
- Member of at least one CDE team

- Exhibited in KISD show
- Have 25 hours of community service
- Have a desire to receive this degree
- Be willing to work thru the process, including meeting deadlines.
- Attend the FFA convention in July to receive your degree.

KISD Livestock Show - Meeting Discussion Notes

Livestock Show Logistics of Animals

1. We will move all barn animals on Wednesday prior to 2 PM.
2. You will get these instructions from your species advisor on feeders, waterers, feed, equipment, etc.
3. You must be present to weigh in your goats, lambs and steers at 3 PM. Hogs will weigh as they arrive.
4. It is a terminal show, make sure you understand that this is final.
5. No bunnies are allowed to be carried around.

Behavior

1. Dress code when showing, selling and the parade will be official dress.
2. School dress code is required for all other times.
3. Behavior is expected to be exemplary
4. Pitch in to help when needed, and watch other CRFFA kids show and cheer for them.
5. Listen to any CRHS teacher – when they tell you something.

Time Expectations

1. Normal school hours you will be at pavilion. (Barn opens daily at 6 AM)
2. We will check in daily by species and have a general meeting each day.
3. Species advisors may set additional times for you.
4. You may not leave to get lunch. Rodeo tickets will be handed out each day at the conclusion of the last show.
5. If you are not there, you will be truant and held liable as such.
6. School excusal form needs to be turned in to Mr. Ford by Friday, 2/8/19. No excusals without this form!
7. Barn closes nightly at 7 PM. (Saturday at 6 PM) Be finished with your chores and out.

Parade

1. Buses will load at 7:30 a.m. sharp at the pavilion. Parade ends at KHS – you must ride the bus back to the pavilion.
2. If you are a Champion or Reserve Champion in species or Showmanship, or a Chapter Officer, you will ride the champions float/Officer truck with your banner.
3. Green hand painting is a tradition, so get ready for that. It happens Saturday morning at 7:00.

Sale Specifics

1. The premium sale will be the top 118 projects. Pre-Sale meeting is on Friday, and chair duty on Sunday.
2. The barn sale is for all others, and there is no guaranteed buyer. You do not go thru a sale ring for this.
3. Everyone can get add-ons. If your add on exceeds freezer price – it is considered sold at 5 PM.

4. Be on time to sell, only CRFFA kids can go on the sale block with CRFFA kids.

Clean Out/Deadlines

1. All items must be removed from pavilion 1 hour after the premium sale is completed.
2. Your pen at the barn must be cleaned out prior to March 2, 2019.
3. All items left at either the pavilion or the barn become property of CRFFA.
4. Thank-you letters are due April 1, 2019 to Miss Kacal.

Misc.

1. Calf scramble times and days are listed on the back. Meet in the pavilion at 6:30 p.m.
2. Parade of champions at the rodeo occurs Friday night and Saturday night. Be present in official dress with your banners by 6:30 PM.
