Animal Selection

This year we will draw for animal selection on Friday, October 5, 2018. It will work like a drive thru. Drive up to the LD Robinson Pavilion between 3 and 5pm and draw your number. Animal selection will be at the same location Saturday, October 6, 2018 beginning with pigs at 7am.

Activities Above the Chapter Level

All exhibitors in the Katy ISD Livestock Show must participate in at least 2 activities above the chapter level to meet their activity requirement to show. The following activities will fulfill these requirements and are quickly approaching.

- **Leadership Development Event** (*activity above the chapter level*)

LDEs have already started! These events allow students to present and test their knowledge on information about different facets of agriculture. Practice competitions will be soon and District competition will be here before we know it!

- **Ag Olympics**

Saturday, Sept. 29. Check in: 8:30am at the Ag Barns. Starts: 9:00am

Parking:if you are driving yourself, you **MUST PARK AT Paetow High School** and ride the bus to the ag barns (Ms. Warhol-Seven Lakes Ag teacher will be driving it)

Bus will start making trips at 8:00 from Paetow HS to the Barns.

If you plan to park at Paetow, you must have a temporary parking pass which can be found in the ag hallway file rack.

Drop off: You can be dropped off at the ag barns by a parent, but no parking
DO NOT PARK AT THE BARNs

On Monday, Oct. 8th (early release day), members are invited to attend the KISD FFA Leadership Summit beginning at 1-3:45, at Morton Ranch High School. Members from each Katy ISD school will be in attendance. Members should take advantage of this activity close to home to receive credit for an activity above the chapter level. Students must provide their own transportation and the registration cost is \$10 with Ms. K by October 5. Details will be posted in the ag hallway.

Community Service

- We have just completed our first community service project of the year - Blanket Bash! With the help of those who donated and came to help make the blankets, we were able to donate 30 blankets to Texas Children's Hospital!!
- Students also have the opportunity to make stick horses for the Katy ISD Rodeo Event. Students will earn 4 hours of community service for their participation. Students will go to 1928 Drexel Drive; Katy, TX 77493 at 10am on Saturday, November 3rd. It will last from 9am to 1pm.

*** Participation in all community service activities will accumulate toward the 10 hour community service requirement needed to show.

All CRHS Greenhands (first year members) planning to show at the KISD Livestock Show are required to recite the FFA Creed to any Advisor on or before Friday, December 7th. All students in Principles of AFNR are doing this in class.
