- Leadership Development Event

Members can join a Leadership Development Event (LDE) Team to be counted as an activity. These events allow students to present and test their knowledge on information about different facets of agriculture. Listen for details to be shared, invitations to be given, and practice schedules to be announced.

All FFA Members are welcome to participate at the school barns for a day of fun and competition among all Katy ISD FFA members. KISD Ag Olympics will be held at the Gerald D. Young Agricultural Science Facility (school barns) on Sat. September $28^{\text {th }}$ from 9:00 am to noon. You may register with Mrs. Jenschke by September 20; it will be $\$ 20$.

## - Katy ISD Livestock Seminar

Start your project off right with information from Industry Experts at the Katy ISD Livestock Feed and Management Seminar, on Wednesday, September 25. There will be a presentation for each species (Lambs, pigs, and goats). The seminar will be at the new LD Robinson Pavilion (5825 Katy Hockley Cut Off). Check in will begin at 5:30pm.
